Roasted Spring Vegetables

6 oz. Asparagus cut into 2-inch lengths

6 oz. Baby Carrots

6 oz. Yellow Squash

6 oz. Zucchini

3 Tbsp. Salted Butter, melted

3 cloves Garlic, minced

1 tsp. Parsley, finely chopped

Salt to taste

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. Combine veggies. Add in the remaining ingredients and stir to mix well.
- 3. Make sure all vegetables are coated evenly. Arrange in a single layer on a baking sheet lined with parchment.
- 4. Roast for 12-15 minutes. Serve immediately.
